Dear Yale Public Schools Parents/Guardians,

The St. Clair County Health Department has asked us to provide each student with information regarding the upcoming FREE second H1N1 Vaccination Clinic that will be held in the Yale School District.

The St. Clair County Health Department has scheduled a free  
H1N1 Vaccination Clinic in the Yale School District:

**Farrell-Emmett Elementary - Tuesday, December 15, 2009**

*Any child under the age of 10 years may receive his/her required 2<sup>nd</sup> dose,  
other community members and students may receive their 1<sup>st</sup> dose at this clinic.*

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION VERY CAREFULLY!

1. If you plan to have your child immunized, you are welcome to accompany your child to the clinic, however, your presence is not required if the child's consent form is complete with signature and sent with the child.
2. If your child is receiving the first or second dose, you will need to complete a consent form. Please obtain one from your child's school building office. These forms are also available through local public libraries and the health department.
3. Also, if your child is receiving the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, the health department requires proof of the first dose that includes the date and type of vaccination. Send with your child the (yellow) immunization card that was supplied by the health department at the first dose –or- a copy of the vaccination record from your private provider.

We want to be sure all elementary students have ample opportunity to receive vaccination before they go home. To accomplish this, we have designated 2:00-3:30 p.m. for our elementary students. From 3:30 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. is available for junior high and high school students and other community members.

2:00 – 3:30 P.M.	Elementary Students
3:30 – 7:00 P.M.	Junior High/High School Students
3:30 – 7:00 P.M.	Community members, particularly those of concern include:

- Pregnant women
- Children between 6 months and 24 years
- Health care workers/emergency first responders
- Care givers of children under 6 months of age
- Anyone 25-64 with an underlying health conditions
